BINTULU PORT NOTICE No. 11 of 2022 Date: 27 May 2022

To: <u>Importers/Consignees, Shipping Lines/Shipping Agents/Non-Vessel</u> <u>Owning Common Carrier, Forwarding Agents/ Freight Forwarding</u>

Applicable to : This notice is brought to the attention of and not limited to ship manager/owner, agent, master and officer, crew of ships, terminal operator and port operator.

NOTICE FOR COLLECTION OF CONTAINER DEPOSIT

- 1. The Ministry of Transport Malaysia urges Importers/Consignees, Shipping Lines/Shipping Agents/Non-Vessel Owning Common Carrier (NVOCC), Forwarding Agents/ Freight Forwarding to adhere to decisions made by National Logistics Task Force, which are as follows:
 - i. Shipping Lines/Agents/NVOCCs have to observe three (3) alternatives for container deposit in Malaysia:
 - a. Non Cheque Deposit (NCD) Scheme; or
 - b. Container Ledger Account (CLA); or
 - c. iCargo+
 - ii. All parties that have subscribed to either one of the three (3) alternatives mentioned shall be exempted for container deposit.
- 2. In that regards, Bintulu Port Authority agrees that all port users may choose any of the said alternatives in accordance to their operational needs.

3. Enclosed is the letter from YB Minister of Transport Malaysia dated 23 September 2020 for your reference.
