NOTICE FOR COLLECTION OF CONTAINER DEPOSIT

- The Ministry of Transport Malaysia urges Importers/Consignees, Shipping Lines/Shipping Agents/Non-Vessel Owning Common Carrier (NVOCC), Forwarding Agents/ Freight Forwarding to adhere to decisions made by National Logistics Task Force, which are as follows:
 - i. Shipping Lines/Agents/NVOCCs have to observe three (3) alternatives for container deposit in Malaysia:
 - a. Non Cheque Deposit (NCD) Scheme; or
 - b. Container Ledger Account (CLA); or
 - c. iCargo+
 - ii. All parties that have subscribed to either one of the three (3) alternatives mentioned shall be exempted for container deposit.
- In that regards, Labuan Port Authority agrees that all port users may choose any of the said alternatives in accordance to their operational needs.
